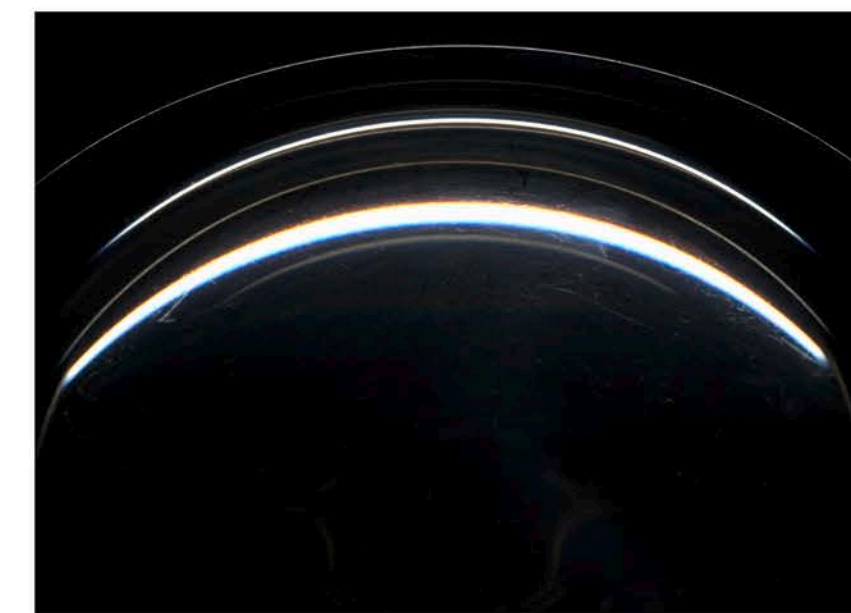
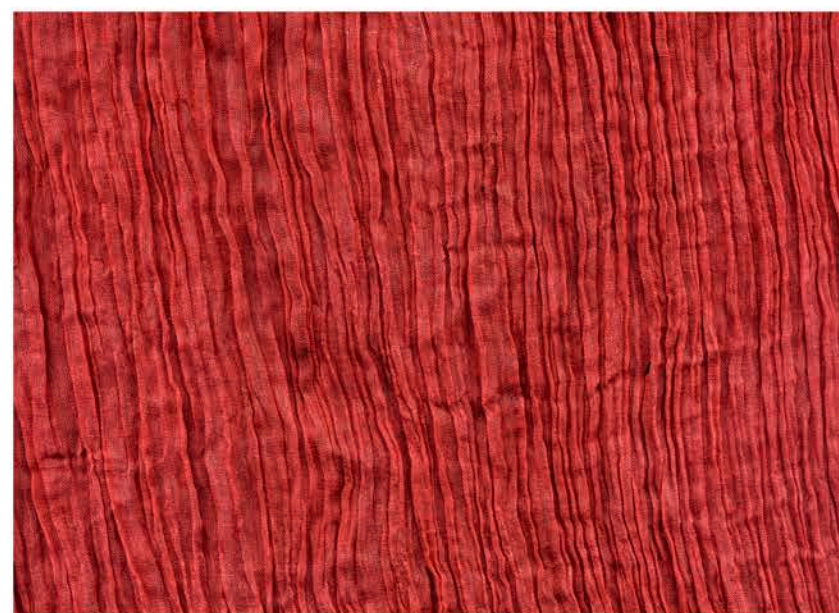
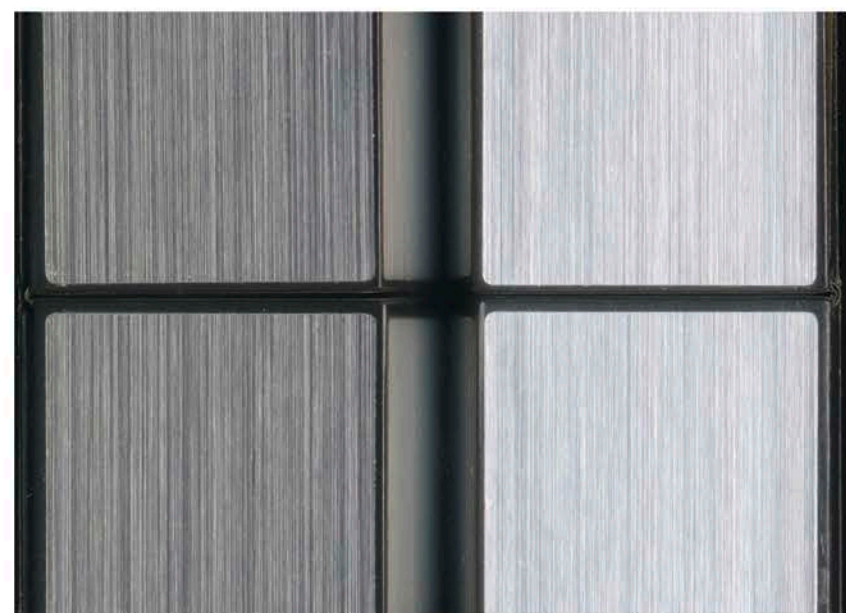


# *Les petits riens*
